Donald Louis Parson was born September 18, 1947 in Hushpuckina, Mississippi. He lived in Mississippi until the age of 5 when his father was called to pastor the First Baptist Church of West Helena, Arkansas. He accepted Christ at age 8 during a

revival service at the First Baptist Church. At age 10, his father was called to pastor Silver Mountain Baptist Church on the north side of Chicago, and there Donald served as a junior deacon.

On October 28, 1959, at the age of 12, he accepted the call into the ministry. His first message was entitled, "For God So Loved The World." He traveled with his father as the "Boy Evangelist" while also preaching for many youth days and revivals in Chicago and surrounding areas. His formative years of schooling were spent at Jenner Elementary, Cooley Junior High and Robert Waller High School, all on Chicago's north side.

At the age of 19, Rev. Parson was called to pastor his first church, Jerusalem Baptist Church in Gary, Indiana. He accepted the call to pastor Mount Calvary Baptist Church on Chicago's far south side in April 1973. Under his leadership, Mount Calvary's membership grew to over five thousand.

On November 6, 1991, he organized the, Logos Baptist Assembly, with 256 members. Under his leadership, Logos has grown to over 7,000 in twenty years! Logos Baptist Assembly is a full-service ministry with three services on Sunday, Bible Study on Tuesday and weekly services & programs for men, women, teens, children, widows and seniors.
